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Wedding bells on the QT?

QUENTIN Tarantino — one of Hollywood's perennial eligible bachelors — is in no rush to get married, even though he is said to have given his on-and-off girlfriend **Daniella Pick** (inset) a "commitment gift."

The director of "Pulp Fiction" and "Inglourious Basterds" turned 54 on Monday and celebrated with a party in Los Angeles, but Pick, 33, an Israeli singer he met eight years ago, did not attend.

"She is not in L.A. She is fighting with Quentin," a Tarantino insider told me. "He wants [to be married] for a few years and then have children. She wants a baby now. She doesn't want to wait."

Tarantino has been linked to a string of women, including **Kathy Griffin**, **Mira Sorvino**, **Sofia Coppola** and his "Kill Bill" star **Uma Thurman** (right), who is said to have bro-



ken his heart when she had a baby with French financier **Arpad Busson** in 2012. But Tarantino's never been married or even engaged.

The auteur is said to have given Pick a ring and necklace as a token of his love. "Daniella promised to keep this a secret, but she couldn't help blabbing to friends," my source said.

Representatives for Tarantino and Pick did not get back to me.

Tarantino groupies will be watching to see if Pick comes to the Tribeca Film Festival on April 28, when the director hosts a 25th anniversary screening of his film "Reservoir Dogs," followed by a Q&A.

"Her family is pressuring her because her sister has children and she has to catch up," said my source. "She tells Quentin her clock is ticking."
