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Sarubbi Wants Action On Waterfront 'Hippies'

Mayor Angelo Sarubbi of North Bergen wants the township to do something about its neighbors — an artists' colony living in rented barges on the Hudson riverfront which can be seen from the picture windows of Sarubbi's plush, ultramodern construction offices.

Township officials consider the tenants "hippies" and are considering legal action to remove them from the rented barges at the Lord Drydock on River Road. Officials say some are living in rooms with a chair and a bed. Others have installed wooden stoves which are a potential hazard, they state.

Their landlord, however, disagreed with the characterization of her tenants. Mrs. Aud-

rey Boyer, who leases the land and water site from the state, said at her New York real estate office, "I would like to make one thing clear and that is these people we are renting dock space to are not hippies. They are artists and very famous artists."
